MAKING MONEY WITH THE ART OF BOXING

GLENN Rushton is a rare breed in the financial industry.

The Olympic boxing coach had been a bricklayer, photographer, health food shop owner and developer before turning his hand to investment management more than a decade ago.

Mr Rushton, who with his son Lee runs Rushton Financial Services, said there was a psychology in the stock market just as there was in the boxing ring.

“Making money is a science, just like boxing,” said Rushton, who manages about \$70 million of funds for retirees and other investors.

“It is all about knowledge and

having confidence in yourself.

When he is not watching the markets, Rushton is usually busy at the side of Olympic hopeful Joe Goodall.

Mr Rushton, who has also coached Australian Olympian Jeff Horn, has a state-of-the-art training ring only metres from his office in his \$10 million Stretton home.

“Like boxing you have to manage your risk in investing,” Mr Rushton said.

“You don’t want to get hit too much.”
